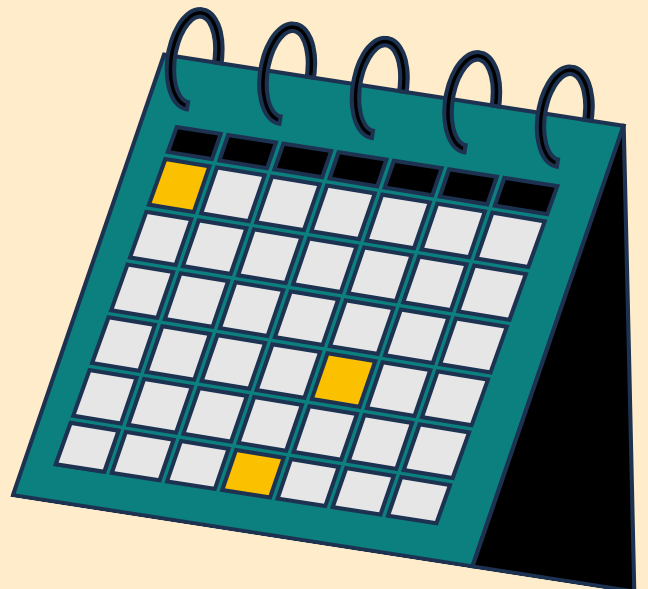

Sign up to O2 Wi-Fi

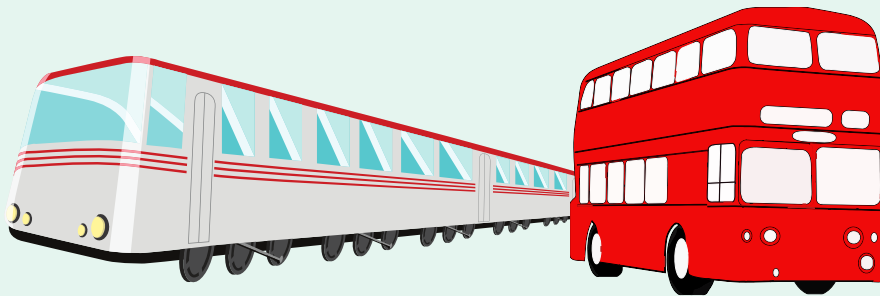

The easiest place to buy Oyster Cards is at Underground Station ticket offices. To buy an Oyster card in a London Underground Station, you will need to pay £7. This is the cost of the card only. you will need to add further credit to travel.

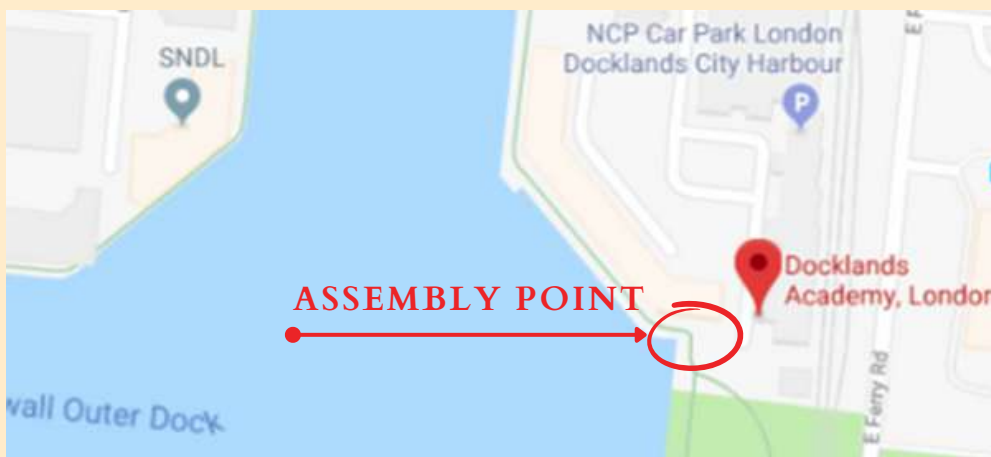

- While travelling, students should carry a small amount of British pounds/US dollars with them to cover routine travelling costs such as food and water. · Up-to-date weather reports can be found by visiting Oxford Weather or the equivalent websites for your summer school location. Please note that the UK is famous for variable weather, even in July and August, and a range of clothes should be packed.
- On arriving and leaving the premises, students must be signed in and out by parents/carers with our Welfare Officer.
- You must attend all classes punctually for anything other than illness or exceptional circumstances.
- If you need to miss a class, you, or someone acting on your behalf should inform your lecturer immediately and/or the reception, where possible in advance, (eg. for a doctor's or dentist's appointment) by means of a telephone call, email and etc.
- You may be denied access to classes if they are more than 15 minutes late, unless there are good reasons. The same rule applies for online sessions at distance learning.
- Students must have a minimum in-class attendance rate of 90% in order to meet the requirements of their courses. Failure to adhere to the attendance requirements may result in:
 - exclusion from the programme or being withdrawn,
 - expulsion for international students where they will be reported to UKVI. We are required to inform the UKVI if you are frequently absent and do not provide a doctor's certificate or other acceptable reason. This may affect your visa status.

Newham Hospital has a walk in centre which deals with urgent problems such as minor illnesses and small injuries.

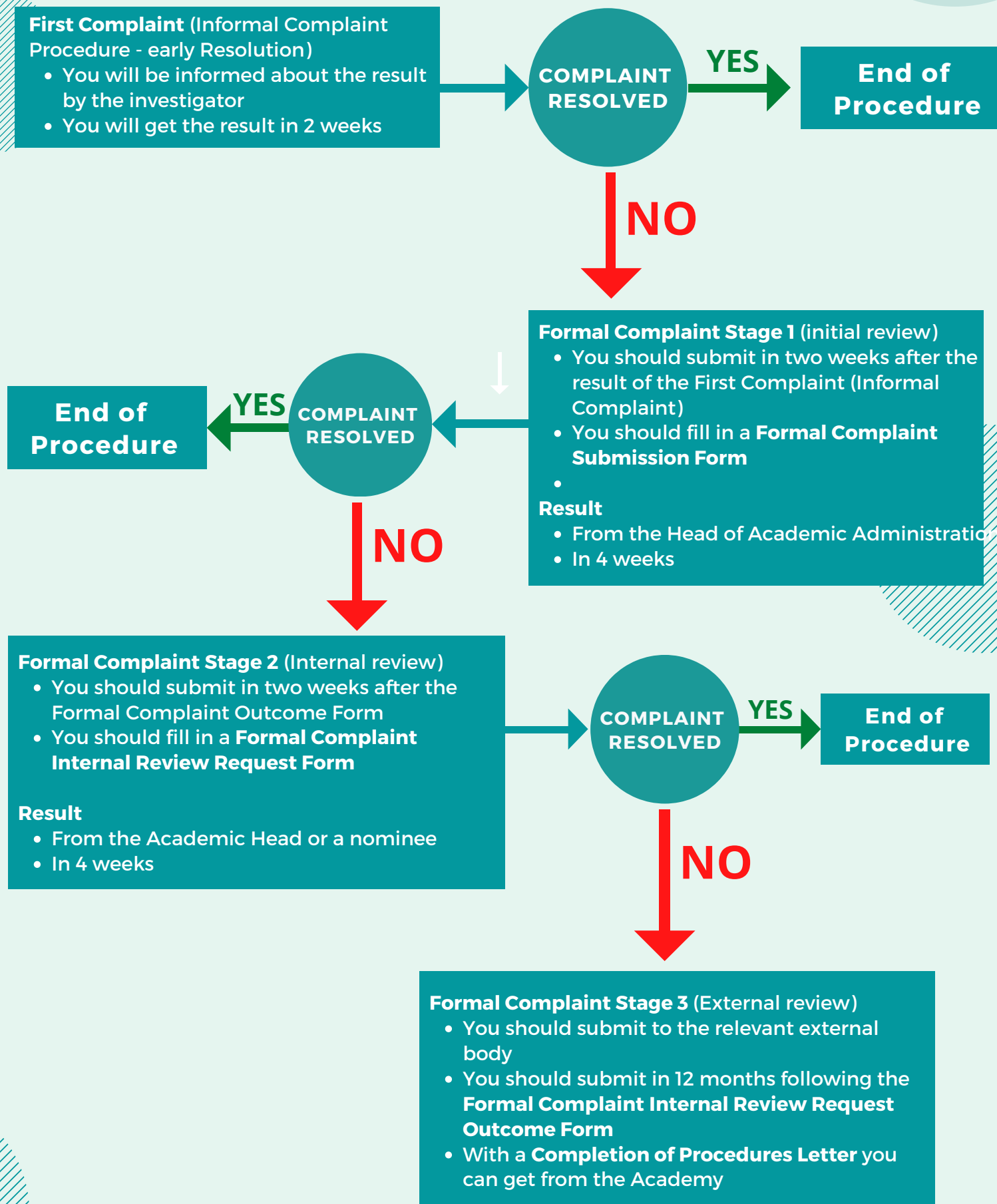
